Power Boats around French Island Cruise 07/01/2024

Certificate of Currency

There has been some confusion about submitting a Certificate of Currency for your boat. The owner of every boat whether in the marina or a ramp user, must provide a Certificate of Currency to the office when the boat insurance is renewed. No exceptions. These certificates are readily available from your insurance company by making a simple phone call to the broker who will instantaneously email a copy to you. Be prepared for a follow up from Bill McIntosh our Safety Supervisor if the new certificate is not lodged. In those cases, your access to the marina or ramp will be suspended until such time that the certificate is received.

Syndicated Berths

Notice is hereby given that within 30 days of this notice syndicated berths will be grandfathered and no longer available. The committee has made the decision on the basis that the provision has rarely been used and there has been no interest for many years.
